## **LESSON OVERVIEW**

**Big Idea:** Jesus came from heaven to earth to fix the world. **Key Question:** What did Jesus do to make us right with God? **Memory Verse:** We are made right with God by placing our faith in Jesus. **Romans 3:22** 

**Overview:** We're continuing our journey through the whole Bible. It's the most important book ever written! We've already learned that even though it's a really big book, it tells one story. It's all about Jesus. We started at the beginning when God created everything, including people. We learned through many stories in the Old Testament that people kept messing up, sinning, against God. Because of sin, our relationship with God was broken. We also learned that the people asked for a king to help them to live to honor God. But even a king couldn't help them with their sin. There was only one person who could fix the sin problem. His name is Jesus. That's where our journey starts today. Even though the whole Old Testament pointed to Jesus, we don't actually meet him until the opening of the New Testament. We'll learn that Jesus came from heaven to earth to die on a cross to fix the sin problem that had been around since the very first book of the Bible. Jesus is the only one that can make us right with God again.

Jesus came to pay the consequences for OUR sins so that we could be made right with God. Jesus fixed our sin problem.
20 min	<b>LARGE GROUP:</b> Gather for songs and videos with other kids. Then return to small group to finish this guide.	<b>Bonus Questions:</b> Why do you think Jesus was willing to do that for us? How can you show your thanks to Jesus for dying on the cross for you?
 5 min 	<b>RECAP:</b> Read the Lesson Overview from the Teacher's Guide and then answer the KEY QUESTION.	To be "dead" to sin means that we don't have to be controlled by sin anymore. When Jesus died on the cross, He gave us the ability to say "no" to sin and "yes" to God. To be
 5 min 	<b>EXPLORE:</b> Read <u>Romans 6:9-11</u> . What does it mean to be "dead" to the power of sin? What can you do to show you are "alive" for God?	"alive" means we've put our trust in Jesus and can live to honor Him. (read your Bible, pray, be a good friend, forgive those who hurt your feelings, be helpful to parents and teachers)
 10 min	<b>PLAY:</b> Choose a group activity from Activity Page #2.	
 5 min	<ul> <li>CLOSE:</li> <li>How can you share Jesus with your friends?</li> <li>Share prayer requests and pray as a class.</li> </ul>	Jesus' gift of forgiveness is something we should want to share with our friends. Have kids share ways they can talk about Jesus with their friends.

# Option #1

## **Cross Craft**

Make a cross to remember what Jesus did for us! Give each kid two popsicle sticks. Have them color the sticks in a creative way. Then, have them glue one across the other to make a cross. Let it dry for a few minutes. Once dry, give each kid a red piece of yarn and a white piece of yarn. Have them wrap the red yarn around where the sticks intersect, going from right bottom to left top, Have them glue the end that remains to the stick. Then, have them do the same with the white yarn, but this time wrapping from left bottom to right top. Glue the end down. The desired effect is a criss cross pattern of red and white.

As you do this craft, explain the following:

- 1. The cross is where Jesus died for our sins
- 2. The red yarn represents Jesus paying for your sin
- 3. The white yarn represents the new life we have in Jesus.



# Option #2

## **Cutout Cross**

Cut and color a cross to remember all that Jesus did for us! Give each kid a cross template (page 5) and have them cut it out, along with the box with the verse. Give each kid a piece of red and white paper also. Have them rip the red and white paper into small pieces. Glue the red pieces onto the cross, going across and the white paper pieces going down. This will give it a mosaic effect. Then have them glue the verse template onto the red part of the cross. As kids are making the craft, point out the things below.

As you do this craft, explain the following:

- 1. The cross is where Jesus died for our sins
- 2. The red paper pieces represents Jesus paying for your sin
- 3. The white paper pieces represents the new life we have in Jesus.

#### **Supplies needed**

- popsicle sticks, 2 per kid
- elmers or wood glue
- markers
- red yarn
- white yarn







